

Because they hate us?

- Terrorism and violent extremism are values based-
- Violent extremism as fundamentally a national security issue-
- Violent extremism can only be perpetrated by (and responsibility of) those who are NOT us-
- Countering violent extremism is a futile exercise-



Secularism

- Section 116 of the Constitution :
- the Commonwealth shall not make any law for establishing any religion, or for imposing any religious observance, or for prohibiting the free exercise of any religion, and no religious test shall be required as a qualification for any office or public trust under the Commonwealth.

Counter radicalisation Society Civil society, government, private sector Counter narratives


