




Bourdieu's Cultural Capital

#	Top 10 Factors	Responses	Percentage (n = 1241)
1	Friends and other outside influence	460	37.1%
2	External distractions	169	13.6%
3	Anti-social school behaviour	145	11.7%
4	Individual decisions and attitudes	95	7.7%
5	Nothing (everything's okay)	88	7.1%
6	Negative self-talk and thoughts	65	5.2%
7	Family commitments and issues	55	4.4%
8	Bullying	36	2.9%
9	Unsupportive or conflict with Teachers	24	1.9%
10	Sporting commitments	19	1.5%

Other factors

- Subject / Understanding difficulty
- No support
- I don't know
- Other reasons
- Lack of resources
- Financial issues
- No supportive learning environment
- Church commitments





#	Top 5 Factors	% (n=16)
1	Money	22%
2	Lack of encouragement / support	11%
3	Interpersonal struggles / attitudes	10%
4	Negative peer pressure	9%
5	Learning barriers	8%
